STUDENT PARKING

If you are driving yourself to school you need to stop by the Main Office and fill out a parking permit application so that you can receive your student parking permit sticker. Office hours are Monday – Friday, 7:30 am – 4:30 pm.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE/PICKUP

If you will need to pick up your student before the school day ends, please send them in the morning with a note to the Main Office. That way we can have your student ready for pickup at the time you need them.

To avoid receiving the automated attendance call if your student is absent, please contact the Main Office as soon as possible.

The Main Office hours are Monday – Friday 7:30 am – 4:30 pm.

STUDENT MEDICATIONS

If your student has medical issues or needs to take medications during the school day we need to hear from you ASAP! The medications will need to be delivered to the main office by the parent/guardian (NOT the student). We will ask the parent to complete forms for each medication your student takes. Even if your student has medication they need to keep with them during the school day i.e.: inhaler or epi pen or if your student takes an over the counter medication i.e.: cough drops or Advil, we need to have a parent signed form on file.
