

Individuals who lost an immediate family member who worked in healthcare to COVID-19-related causes, this scholarship program is for you.

The Brave of Heart Fund will be awarding scholarships from \$15,000 to \$25,000 each per academic year to individuals planning to enroll in fulltime or part-time undergraduate study or a patient-facing medical profession graduate study.

Eligible applicants must:

- Be children, spouses or domestic partners of frontline healthcare workers* who lost their lives to COVID-19-related causes
- Plan to enroll in full-time or part-time (minimum 6 credit hours or equivalent) undergraduate or graduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college or university, or vocational-technical school in the upcoming academic year
- Be a United States (U.S.) citizen or legal resident living in and attending an educational institution in the U.S. or a U.S. territory
- Have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent). Nontraditional students are encouraged to apply and will be considered even if they do not have a recent GPA

*An eligible frontline healthcare worker is a person who lived in the United States at the time of death and who worked or volunteered in or for a: licensed hospital, medical center or clinic, nursing home, medical transport vehicle, triage center, or other licensed medical facility, provider, or setting, or who worked or volunteered as an emergency medical technician, ambulance technician or paramedic. The individual must have had the possibility of exposure to patients with COVID-19 while working or volunteering.

Deadline to apply is October 5, 2022 at 3:00pm CST.
