PHYSICAL EXAMINATIONS OF STUDENTS

Parents of students entering the North Country Charter Academy must present proof of meeting the physical examination and immunization requirement within thirty days (30) of entrance. Failure to comply with this provision may result in exclusion from school for the child.

However, no medical examination shall be required of a child whose parent or guardian objects thereto in writing on the grounds such medical examination is contrary to his/her religious tenets and teachings.

A student shall be exempted from the above immunization requirements if he/she presents evidence from his/her physician that immunization will be detrimental to his/her health. A student shall be excused from immunization for religious reasons upon the signing of a notarized form by the parent/guardian stating that the student has not been immunized because of religious beliefs.
