#### Dear Parishioners,

Happy Ordinary Time. Too often, we might overlook the power of the ordinary time. As we pack up the Christmas decorations, consume the last of the goodies, attend the last of the parties, the temptation to put away the meaning of these days might be strong too.

But we need to take those lessons into this new season, and like the Blessed Mother, ponder them in our hearts. By doing so, we will allow Christ to reign in our hearts. We will be like Charles Dicken's redeemed Scrooge of *A Christmas Carol*, who "was better than his word. He did it all, and infinitely more... He became as good a friend, as good a master, and as good a man as the good old city knew, or any other good old city, town, or borough in the good old world. ... and it was always said of him, that he knew how to keep Christmas well, if any man alive possessed the knowledge."

Recently, I have had several people speak to me about marriage. The Church is concerned, and therefore I am, with helping all in irregular marriages or situations. Some are separated from their spouse with good reason, and I encourage them to begin the Tribunal process to ascertain if their marriage was sacramental or not. Others are married or remarried outside the Church, and the Church gives means of making things right so that the marriage may be sacramental and recognized in the Church.

It takes some work, yes, but it is worth doing. For those married outside the Church, in most cases, abstaining from reception of the Eucharist is required while Mass attendance is still required. There is a means that was recommended by St. John Paul II in which the person has the intention and has begun the process of getting the marriage in the Church, going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation, and living 'as brother and sister' in celibacy until such time that the marriage is validated by the Church.

These situations are tricky and difficult, which is why a conversation with a priest is recommended. Please, if you are in a marriage not in the Church or know someone in such a relationship or are divorced and interested in beginning the Tribunal process, schedule a time to meet with me. Let me help you!
