 - Budget line item addition Science Camp: not to exceed \$1000
 - All items were unanimously approved by the board

- Jog-A-Thon: Jog A Thon was a successful event, with final numbers to be posted and shared at the November meeting. Prize winners seemed very happy with their prizes and the teachers running in inflatable costumes was a success. To improve next year, the speaker system will be moved to a more centralized location so it is easier for everyone to hear the music and announcements
- PFC attended the staff meeting on 9/9, field trip proposals have been submitted

New Business

• Pie sales: Tara shared a sample packet for pie sales. Pies will be sold for \$20 each at a profit of \$8 per pie. Packets will go out in teachers' boxes on Friday to be distributed to

- classes on Monday. The school goal to sell is 1,000 pies with teachers having the option to make goals for their individual classes. Ple sales will begin on October 21st
- Field Trip Proposals, all approved in the budget previously, signed off by Tara Gervase, Tlffany Anderson, and Rachel Henley
 - Second grade, \$411 + Bus for the Gallo Center of the Arts
 - Third grade, \$700 for Knights Ferry
 - o Sixth grade, \$460 for bussing to Old Sacramento & the Capitol building
 - Sixth grade, \$600 for bussing to Science Camp
 - Proposals filed with meeting agenda & minutes
- Christmas Parade: The Christmas parade is on December 12th with the theme of Oh, Christmas Tree. Lauren and Amanda are in charge of the float creation, with the option of children being able to walk with the float if a parent is in attendance
- Shade Structure update: Final quote from Park Planet of \$23,514.93, Mrs. Henley is waiting on confirmation of a color change for the top to gray to prevent fading with red poles to keep with Ripon El's color scheme
- Bylaws Update: The final draft has been submitted to the attorney, waiting on her to send back to the board
- Butter Braids Fundraiser: After strong response to another school's Butter Braids fundraiser, Ripon El will sell Butter Braids in March with an expected pick up at the beginning of April to give a break between holidays and T&T at the end of the year. Tara is waiting on a call back from the representative in Elk Grove. Punkin made the suggestion to have samples ready for families to try as a fundraiser kick off

Treasurer's Report

- The report was read by treasurer Tiffany Anderson, closing the books for September 2024. As of 9/30/24, the money market account balance is \$10,378.69 and the general fund account balance is \$100,211.16. This includes two restaurant fundraisers in September (Jamba Juice \$240 & Twisted Tulip \$300) and \$6016.57 paid to Shirt World for Jog A Thon shirts.
