Comparative of Lin-Wood Public Schools District Data to nearby school districts.

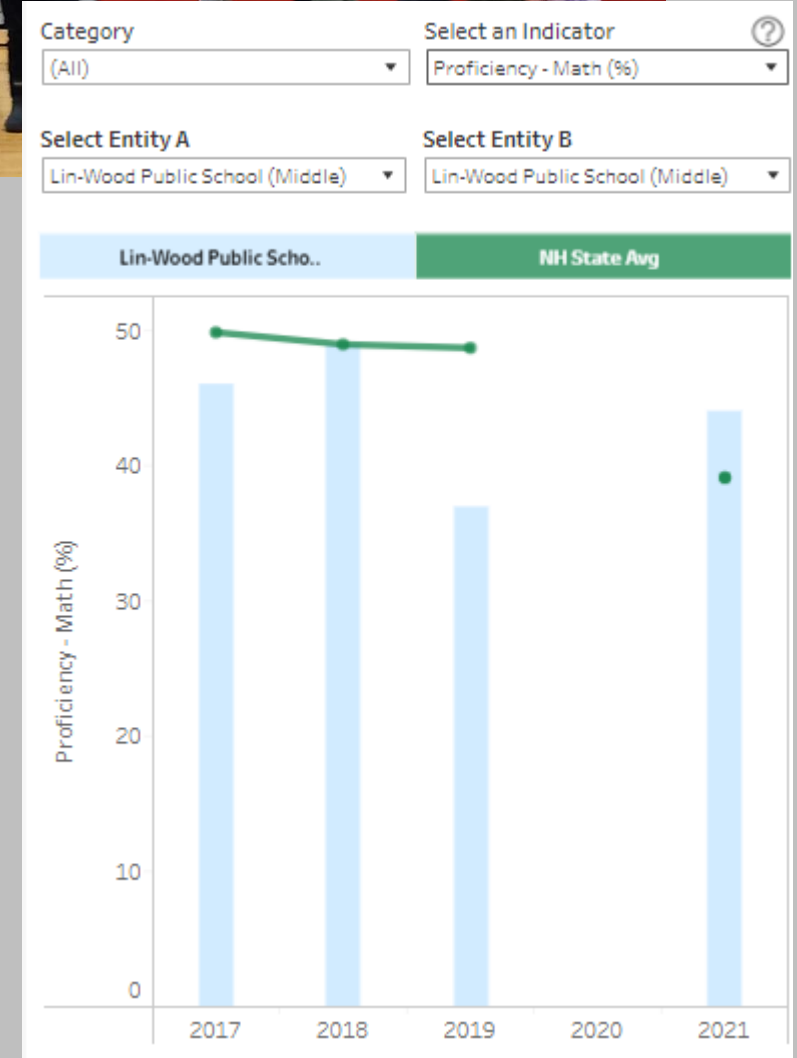
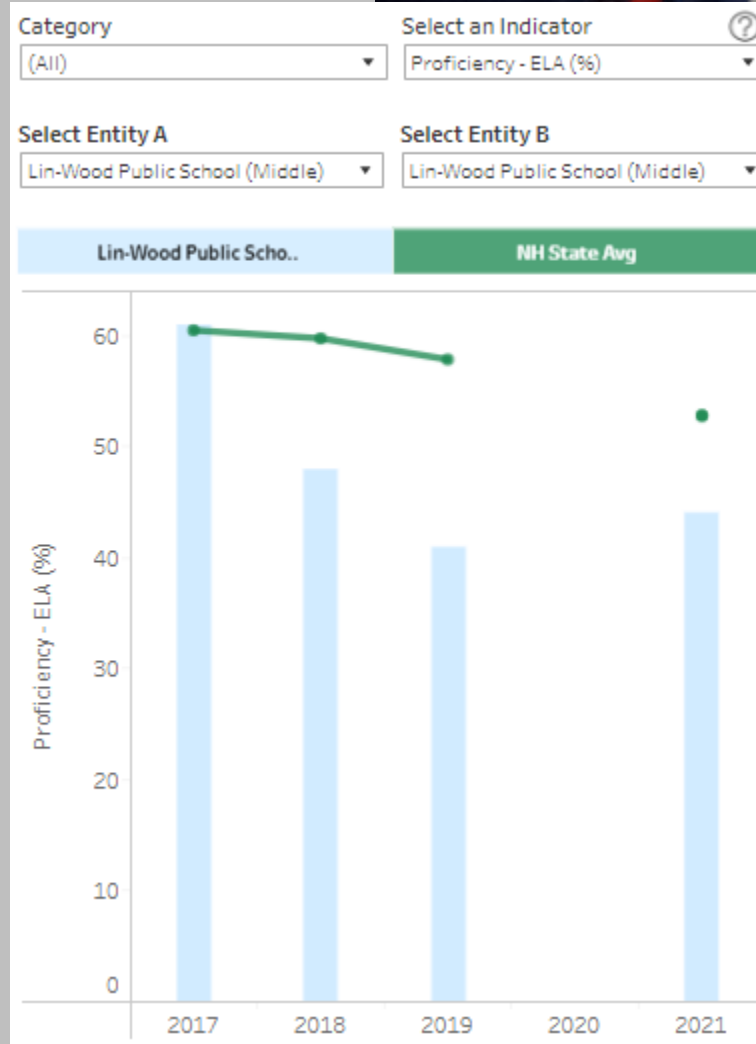
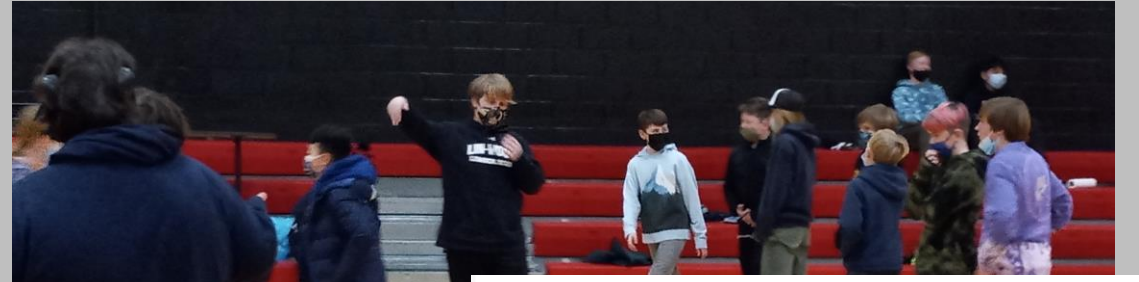

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Comparison of Combined ELA & Math Proficiency



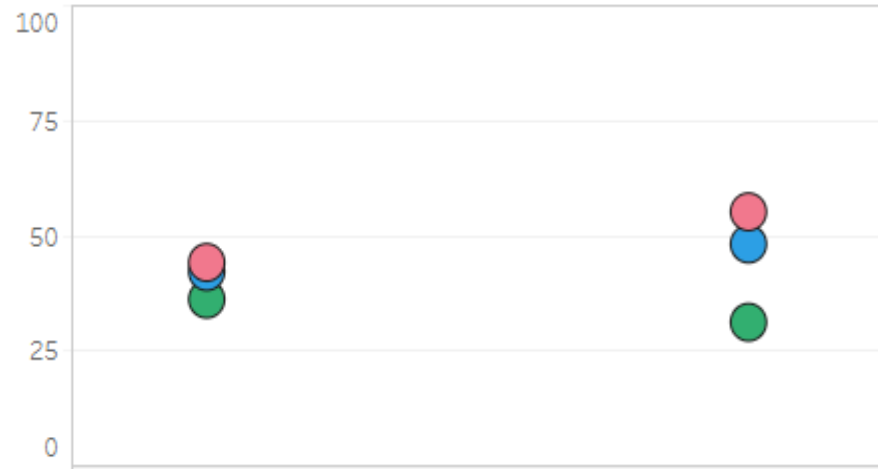

Assessment Proficiency Over Time

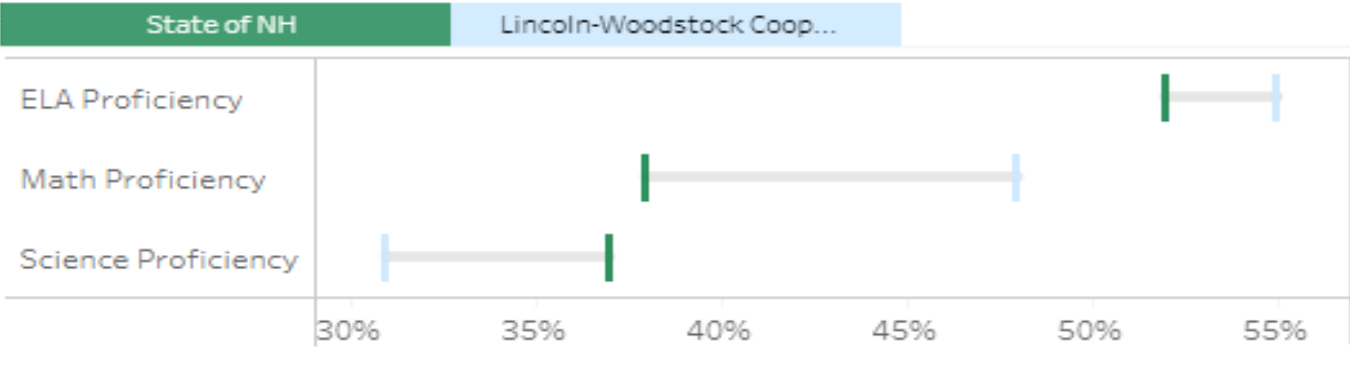
