The Class of 2021 Scholarship is a 2nd term scholarship, meaning it will be paid directly to the recipient's institution in the spring semester. In order to receive this scholarship, recipients must provide an **unofficial college transcript and a list of registered classes** for the spring semester. If these documents are not emailed to sarah.weisbrod@nwcsiowa.edu before **December 31st**, the recipient will forfeit their scholarship. In the case that the recipient un-enrolls during the 1st term, or any time before the 2nd term, their portion of scholarship money will be awarded to someone else. Additionally, the recipient will be required to maintain a 2.5 GPA (C average) in their first semester of secondary education.

 - Community Involvement/Service (Include years and positions held)
 - Honors/Awards
