REPORTING STUDENT PROGRESS

PURPOSE

The Board believes that communication of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and education of each student. The Board acknowledges its responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare and academic progress.

AUTHORITY

The Board directs the establishment of a system of reporting student progress that requires all appropriate staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility and which shall include:

- 1. Academic progress reports.
- 2. Report cards.
- 3. Parent conferences with teachers.
- 4. Academic warning reports

DELEGATION OF RESPONSIBILITY

The CEO, in conjunction with appropriate staff members, shall develop procedures for reporting student progress to parents and guardians.

All appropriate staff members, as part of their professional responsibility, shall comply with the systems established for measuring and reporting student progress

GUIDELINES

Both student and parent shall receive ample warning of a pending grade of failure, or one that would adversely affect the student's academic status. Report cards shall be issued at intervals of not less than nine (9) weeks.
