Please note that a P.O. Box is not acceptable as a residence address. Please carefully read the scenarios listed below and provide the documentation that applies to your living situation. Additional acceptable documents are listed below.

Possible Living Situation #1

If you are living at a property with the owner or renter with no bills in your name and <u>you have moved here from another state</u>, you will need to provide:

- 1. Photo identification for both parent and homeowner/renter.
- 2. A current mortgage statement in the owner's name or Rental Agreement in the tenant's name, which shows residence property address; If the homeowner has a lease/rental agreement, the parent and students must have a letter from the landlord on official letterhead (or notarized) stating they are permitted to live there OR be added to the lease as occupants.
- 3. Utility bill for the homeowner/renter (current within 30 days) or another supporting document (listed below) AND
- 4. Within 30 calendar days, the parent must provide proof of residence at the above address, or the students will be withdrawn. Examples of acceptable residence verification are as follows: utility bill in your name (current month), mail from official government agency, Renters Insurance, Houston County Voter Registration or official Confirmation of Change of Address from the Post Office. Please understand that a cell phone bill or other generic mail is not acceptable.

Possible Living Situation #2

If you are living at a property with the owner or renter and <u>you have moved here from within the State of Georgia</u>, you will need to provide:

- 1. Photo identification for both parent and homeowner/renter.
- 2. A current mortgage statement in the owner's name or Rental Agreement in the tenant's name, which shows residence property address; If the homeowner has a lease/rental agreement, the parent and students must have a letter from the landlord on official letterhead (or notarized) stating they are permitted to live there OR be added to the lease as occupants.
- 3. Utility bill for the homeowner/renter (current within 30 days) or another supporting document (listed below)
- 4. Parent must provide a disconnect notice or termination of lease from the previous address; AND
- 5. Within 30 calendar days, the parent must provide proof of residence at the above address, or the students will be withdrawn. Examples of acceptable residence verification are as follows: utility bill in your name (current month), mail from official government agency, Renters Insurance, Houston County Voter Registration or official Confirmation of Change of Address from the Post Office. Please understand that a cell phone bill or other generic mail is not acceptable.

LIST OF OTHER ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS

- Home mortgage payment book, temporary payment coupon or closing documents (if just purchased within 60 days)
- Utility bill (electric, water, Direct TV, gas or cable bill with service address showing)
- Receipt to have utilities connected (current within 30 days or for future date)
- Property tax statement (current year)
- Automobile registration (current year)
- Car/House insurance bill
- Official mail from any government agency
