every interest and aspiration.



BARBERING

The Barbering program consists of self-paced mastery-based courses. Students are trained to utilize verbal, written, visual, and hands-on instruction throughout the classroom and clinic floor practicum. Students complete the program by earning the 1500 hours needed to sit for the DC State Licensure exam.



GRAPHIC DESIGN



Step into the world of advertising and visual communications! This course introduces students to the exciting field of graphic design and illustration, where creativity meets technology. Students will explore the fundamental elements and principles of visual art and design while building the knowledge and hands-on skills needed for success in the Arts, Audio/Video Technology, and Communications Career Cluster.



Through hands-on projects and real-world applications, students will build industry-ready skills in digital design and illustration. As a capstone, they will be prepared to earn the Adobe Photoshop certification, a valuable credential that opens doors to careers and future opportunities in design.





COSMETOLOGY

The Cosmetology program consists of a self-paced, mastery-based course. The program includes 1500 hours, the requirement for District of Columbia State Board licensing.

Students are trained to utilize verbal, written, visual, and hands-on instruction throughout the classroom and clinic floor practicum.

Along with high-quality technical training, students will learn career development skills such as client consultation, shop management systems, and marketing strategies. Areas of exploration include the history of barbering, professional image and ethics, bacteriology massage and facial treatments, and hair cutting.



HVAC

HEATING, VENTILATION & AIR CONDITIONING

In Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) and Refrigeration Technology I, students will gain knowledge and skills needed to enter the industry as technicians in the HVAC and refrigeration industry or building maintenance industry, prepare for a postsecondary degree in a specified field of construction management, or pursue an approved apprenticeship program. Students will acquire knowledge and skills in safety, principles of HVAC theory, use of tools, codes, and installation of HVAC and refrigeration equipment.



CHILD DEVELOPMENT ASSOCIATES



The CDA pathway examines the growth and development of children and its influence on effective childcare and early education.

Courses emphasizing social, emotional, cognitive, and physical development and the application of theories of child development to early care and education.

Designed for students who may be interested in working with young children as caregivers or teachers in child development centers or daycares.

Students who complete this program will have the opportunity to test their competencies through the national Child Development Associate (CDA) Credential Competencies and Functional Areas and earn their CDA certification



PRINCIPLES OF BUSINESS & MARKETING



In Principles of Business, Marketing, and Finance, students gain knowledge and skills in economies and private enterprise systems, the impact of global business, the marketing of goods and services, advertising, and product pricing. Students analyze the sales process and financial management principles.

This course allows students to reinforce, apply, and transfer academic knowledge and skills to a variety of interesting and relevant activities, problems, and settings in business, marketing, and finance.


