THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET

— *How to Pray* —

The Chaplet is prayed using
ordinary Rosary beads
of five decades.

Make the Sign of the Cross
and say the Optional
Opening Prayers.

Our Father
(on the Our Father bead)

Hail Mary
(on each of the three
Hail Mary beads)

I Believe in God
(on the next
Our Father bead)

Eternal Father,
I offer You the Body and Blood,
Soul and Divinity of Your dearly
beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ,
in atonement for our sins and
those of the whole world.
(on each of the ten Our Father beads)

For the sake of His sorrowful
Passion, have mercy on us and
on the whole world.
(on each of the ten Hail Mary beads)

Repeat for the remaining decades.

Conclude with (three times):

**Holy God, Holy Mighty One,
Holy Immortal One,
have mercy on us and
on the whole world.**

DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Begins on Good Friday and ends on the
day before Divine Mercy Sunday.

1

GOOD FRIDAY
All mankind,
especially sinners.

DAY
2

HOLY SATURDAY
The souls of priests
and religious.

DAY
3

EASTER SUNDAY
Devout and
faithful souls.

DAY
4

EASTER MONDAY
Those who do not
know Christ.

DAY
5

EASTER TUESDAY
The souls of those who are
separated from the Church.

DAY
6

EASTER WEDNESDAY
The meek and humble
souls and children.

DAY
7

EASTER THURSDAY
The souls who especially
venerate and glorify
My mercy.

DAY
8

EASTER FRIDAY
The souls who are detained
in purgatory.

DAY
9

EASTER SATURDAY
The souls who have
become lukewarm.

NOVENA PRAYER (TO BE SAID EACH DAY)

Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood,
Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son,
Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins
and those of the whole world.

CONCLUDING PRAYER (TO BE SAID ON DAY 9)

Eternal God, in Whom mercy is endless and
the treasury of compassion inexhaustible,
look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy
in us, that in difficult moments we might not
despair nor become despondent, but with great
confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will,
which is Love and Mercy itself.
