Even though our transcript includes your SAT/ACT scores, some schools still want official scores sent directly from College Board (SAT) or ACT Corp. You can request your scores online (credit card required) or download a request form available on the internet at the college board website www.collegeboard.org or ACT student website www.actstudent.org. Not sure that you need an 'official' score? Check with the college at which you are applying. Also, there are many students who will need their transcript from Sauk sent to their prospective college. Students who are taking or have taken any classes at Sauk, including WACC dual credit courses and dual credit English can go to Sauk's website to request their official transcript at https://www.svcc.edu/students/admissions/records/pdf/transcript.pdf

When Weather Closes Chadwick and Milledgeville School

When snowstorms, bad roads, or other emergencies make it necessary to close school for a day or more, students and parents will be notified via School Reach telephone calls, radio/TV and by a message on the district website at <u>www.dist399.net</u> as soon as a decision has been reached to close school. Hopefully, this decision will be made no later than 6:30 a.m. The following radio/TV stations will be given this information:

WSDR - Sterling, 1240 AM KROS - Clinton, 1340 AM WSSQ - Sterling, 94.3 FM KCLN - Clinton, 1390 AM WFPS - Freeport, 92 FM KLNT - Clinton, 1390 AM WFRL - Freeport, 1570 AM or 98.5 FM WLLT - Dixon, 107.7 FM WCCI - Savanna, 100.3 FM KWQC TV - Davenport - Channel 6

In case school is dismissed early or it is necessary to delay the running of buses due to inclement weather, you will receive a School Reach phone call and the information will also be posted on the district website and broadcast over the same stations (Note: the email notification system has been discontinued). <u>Regardless of the official action to close or not to close, students and parents</u> are urged always to use discretion in deciding whether or not to travel to school.

School Reach Automated Telephone Contact System

We will utilize the School Reach telephone notification service this year. When the administration decides to close school, dismiss early, or wants to provide an important reminder to parents we will execute a School Reach call. When a School Reach call is made a recorded message will be sent to the contact numbers you provide the school district during registration. Please make sure that the contact numbers we have for your family are accurate and up to date. Warning: In the case of school closing, you will receive phone call notification very early in the morning i.e. 5:00 A.M. If this is not acceptable notify in writing the office secretary in the building your child attends that you would like to be removed from the School Reach telephone notification program.
