### STS Financial Aid Application

Steps to complete the STS Financial Aid Application:

- 1. Log onto the St. Anne School website homepage and click the "Parent" tab at the top of the home page. Scroll down to the "Simple Tuition Solutions Tuition and Tuition Assistance" then click the "STS Tuition Information"
- 2. If you already have an account, click "LOG IN HERE"
- 3. If you do not have an account, click on the Orange Button that says, "Create My Account." Once you create your account will be sent to a page that will allow you to "Start a new Application."

  \*\*\*\*NOTE: You may include ALL your students on one application, even if they attend other private schools.

- 4. The application Process is 8 Steps counting the payment step, each step will save as you advance to the next step. You can use the 8-step tool bar across the top of the page to toggle back to a previous step and make any necessary edits. However, please note, once you complete the process of uploading your required financial documents it will lock the application from all editing. At this point, if any changes would need to be made to the submitting application, you can gladly email STS at support@simpletuitionsolutions.org or call 717.599.7611 option 1.
- 5. After completion of the payment process you will be advised as to which financial document you need to provide STS. You will also be sent an email that outlines what you need to provide, as well as introduce you to the application processor who will be managing the review of your application. PLEASE NOTE: You can simply scan or take a photo of your financial documents and upload them into STS's system using STS's convenient upload feature. This is the fastest way to provide STS with your required financial documentation. However, you can also mail the signed copies of your financial documents to STS to the following address: Simple Tuition Solutions, LLC, P.O. Box 779 Camp Hill, PA 17001. Once your financial documents are loaded, the system will lock the application from all editing. At this point, if any changes would need to be made to the submitting application, you can gladly email STS at support@simpletuitionsolutions.org or call 717.599.7611 option 1.

Finally, once STS has received all the required financial documentation from you, STS's application processors will verify the data and review your entire application per Pennsylvania State Law to determine your eligibility for any State Programs. You will be notified directly via email upon the completion of this verification/review process. In addition, the results will also be available to your School, or any Scholarship Organization associated with the scholarship.

\*\*\*Please note: STS handles the verification and eligibility determination for aid, BUT DOES NOT HAVE ANY input, control, or insight into determination into scholarship amounts or how and when they are awarded.

### **EXTENDED CARE REGISTRATION FORM**

PLEASE FILL OUT FORM COMPLETELY: Non-refundable registration fee of \$35.00 must be submitted by check, cash or money order payable to: St. Anne Extended Care with this application. Or pay through our website donation button

Please check the approximate time(s) your student may attend Extended Care.

St. Anne Extended Care uses ProCare for signing in/out and payments. If you are new to Extended Care, we will create an account for you. ProCare will send you an email, accept the email and get your pin. You can also set up a payment plan on ProCare.

Extended care is \$9.00 per hour. You must pay for the month in advance. Estimate the amount you may use. Invoices are generated via email on the 1<sup>st</sup> of every month for the month prior. Example October 1<sup>st</sup> the invoice for September. If you have a credit, it will carry over, if you owe money you need to pay. You must continue to pre-pay. Your child(ren) will not be allowed to come to Extended Care if you have a delinquent balance or have not prepaid.

You must reapply each year and pay the \$35.00 registration fee.



## **INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC FAQs FOR PARENTS**



#### Does my child need to know how to play an instrument to join?

No. We teach your child everything he/she needs to know to play their musical instrument.

#### When do lessons begin for students?

First lesson dates vary by school. Dates are listed on the enrollment page when you register your child for lessons. Once registered, you can expect an email from your child's teacher within a week of the first lesson.

#### When do lessons occur?

Your child will receive one (1) 30-minute small group lesson each week. All lessons are scheduled during the school day. Lessons are scheduled on a rotating basis so students don't miss the same class each week.

#### What grades are eligible to participate?

In most schools, students can sign up for a string instrument as early as 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, and band instruments starting in 4<sup>th</sup> grade. Some schools have different requirements. Contact your school or music teacher to confirm specific offerings.

#### How much does participation cost?

There are two components to participation in the program: tuition and a **quality** musical instrument. Refer to the attached flyers for tuition and rental instrument pricing.

#### If my child doesn't sign up now, will he/she be able to later?

Although we do not recommend delaying enrollment in the program, we do welcome registrations throughout the year. Students that join the program mid-year will have to work diligently to catch up to their peers. Our teachers will do their best to get your child caught up.

#### Will participation affect my child's grades in other subjects?

It will almost surely help them. Research has shown that band has a positive influence on other studies. Music students consistently average higher grades than non-music students.

Can you be in the band/orchestra and be involved in other school activities like sports, cheerleading, dance, step, chorus, or art?

Absolutely! Most of our music students are involved in other electives and activities.

My child is involved in so many activities. Won't those activities affect his/her performance in band/orchestra and vice versa?

Music students often have many varied interests that make them among the busiest students in the school. The experience that they gain in balancing these interests and activities often proves to be one of life's most valuable lessons.

#### What should I do if my child is struggling?

Practice is a key component for improvement; students must practice in order to improve. If your child is practicing and still struggling with their instrument, contact your child's music teacher for suggestions. Above all else, remain positive and encouraging as your child learns this new skill.

#### Will my child have an opportunity to perform?

Yes! For beginning students, your child will have at least 1 performance this year. For advanced students, there will be a minimum of 2 performance per year. In addition to school concerts, there are other opportunities to perform in our annual Northeastern Honor Band festival, Archdiocese festivals, and other performances arranged by your child's teacher.
