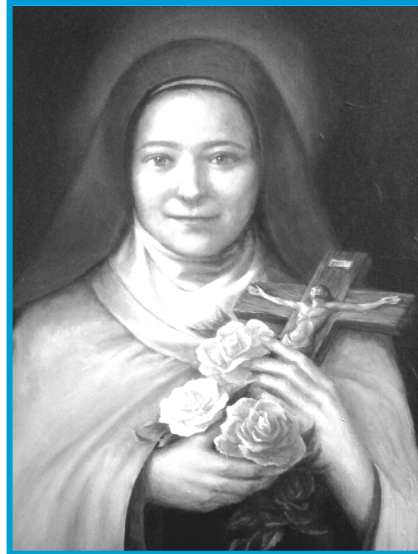

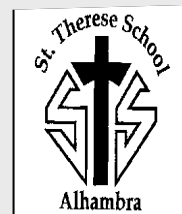

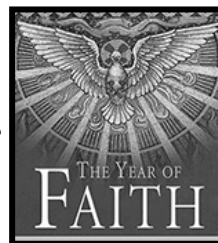

THE YEAR OF FAITH

Pope Benedict XVI declared that a "Year of Faith"

will begin on **October 11, 2012, and conclude on November 24, 2013** (October 11 is the fiftieth anniversary of the opening of the Second Vatican Council and the twentieth anniversary of the publishing of the Catechism of the Catholic Church). During this Year, Catholics are invited to study and reflect on the documents of Vatican II and the Catechism so that they may deepen their knowledge of the faith.

"...they called the Church together and told what God had done and how He had opened the door of faith..." (Acts 14:27)

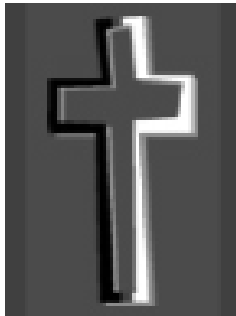


In the Acts of the Apostles, we learn that God "opened the door of faith" for the early Church. In doing so, He has opened the door of faith for each of us—inviting us to step through the threshold into a deeper relationship with Him. The Year of Faith is an opportunity for every Catholic to turn towards Jesus Christ, encounter Him in the Sacraments, especially the Eucharist, and rediscover the Faith and Church. The Year of Faith is a "summons to authentic and renewed conversion to the Lord, the One Savior of the world" (Porta Fidei 6). In other words, it is an opportunity to experience conversion—to turn back to Jesus and enter into a deeper relationship with Him. The "door of faith" was first opened at our baptisms, but during this year Catholics are called to open it again, walk through it, and rediscover and renew their relationship with Christ and His Church.

A MESSAGE FROM THE DIRECTOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION:

Dear Parents, while you are the primary catechists of your children, religious education is a **necessary extension and support** of the foundation that has been laid in the home. If your children are not in a Catholic school, they should be in a Catholic faith formation program. Religious education classes are not simply for children preparing to make their First Communion; rather, they begin in pre-school and then continue through the two-year First Communion preparation, and then **all the way through Eighth Grade**. Then, in high school, your children begin the two-year program to prepare to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, as well as become involved in Youth Ministry. **We urge you to take your children's spiritual lives seriously and register them in a Catholic faith formation program!** May God bless you and your children! —Rhonda Storey

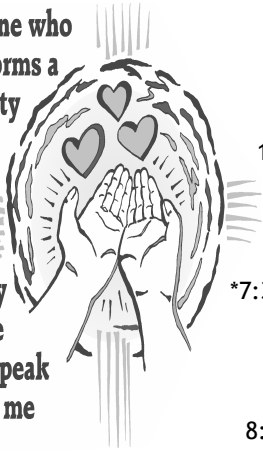

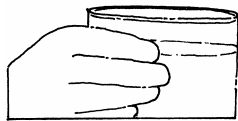

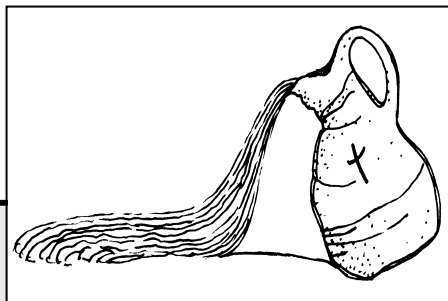
