Practice At Home

- UFLI at home practice will guide you through the spelling pattern we are learning in class. Practice, practice, practice! These spelling patterns come and go quickly!

This Week's Agenda

Spelling: the long /o/ sound with oa, ow, and oe **Oa**: is at the beginning or in the middle of a word

Ow: is used at the end of a syllable. It can go in the beginning or middle of a syllable if it is followed by 'l' or 'n'

Oe: is used at the end of words, but it is an uncommon spelling Reading: We will continue to write to compare our school to other schools around the world. We are turning our notes from last week into a paragraph before we make edits and revisions.

Math: We will begin learning strategies to add two-digit numbers. Science: We will investigate and discover how seeds move.
