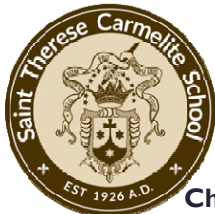

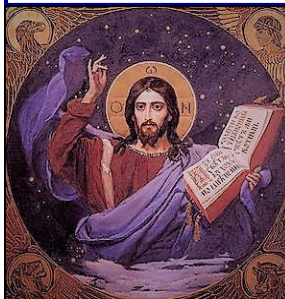

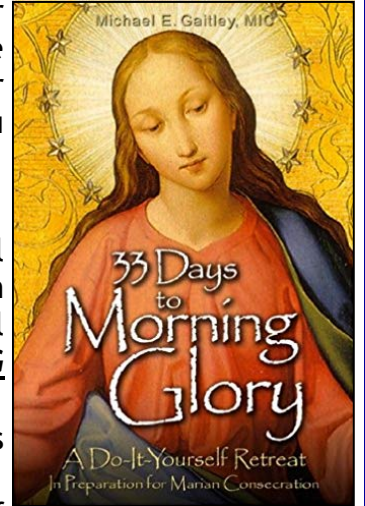


CONSECRATION TO JESUS THROUGH MARY
