Remember as it heats up, try to keep cool by: Staying indoors during the hottest part of the day, drink lots of water, dress cool and eat a Popsicle!!

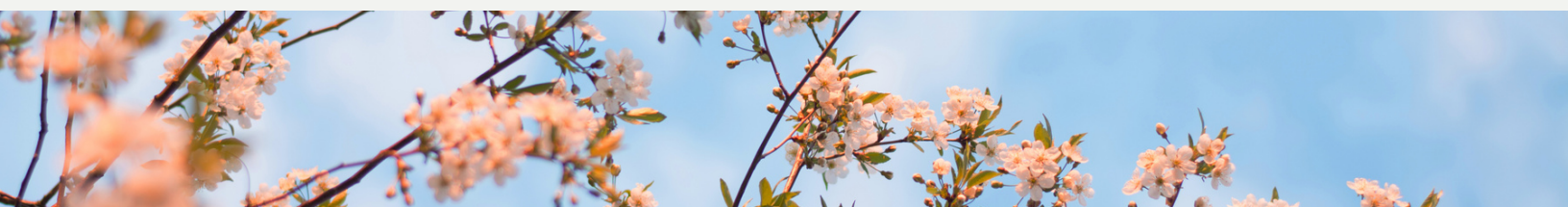

Finishing up our Toolbox this month with the last four Tools:

Please and Thank You Tool = I treat others with kindness and appreciation. Please and Thank you are kind words that let others know you value them. Using these words also encourages others to be helpful and kind. Kindness is magic!!

Apology and Forgiveness Tool = I admit my mistakes and work to forgive others. A sincere, heartfelt apology it is sometimes hard because you must admit you were wrong. Forgiveness takes strength and requires letting go of anger and judgement. It is important to remember that sometimes we need to forgive ourselves too. Learn from your mistakes, forgive yourself and grow from those experiences. Remember everyone makes mistakes!
