

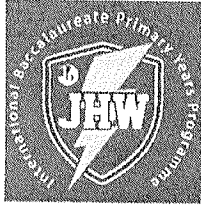

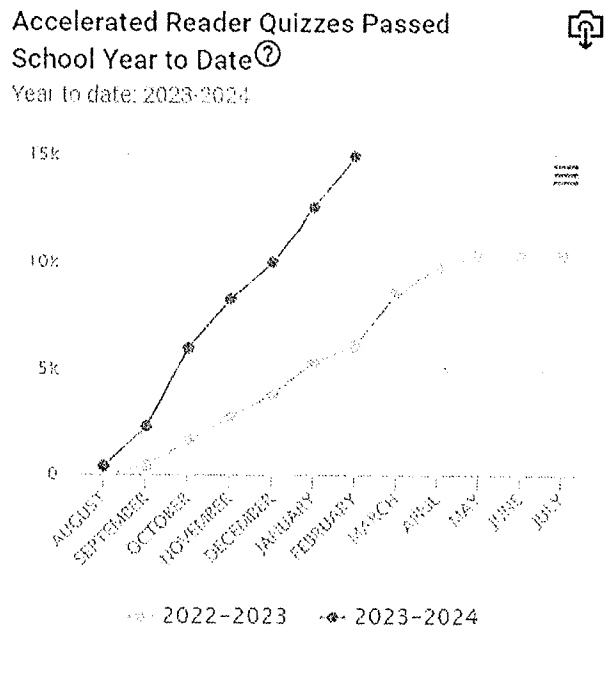

Administrative Report:

- Our 2nd FTE of the 23/24 School Year calculated 437 students. Due to a lower enrollment and the implementation of the state recommended model for ESE.
- Our subgroup data was released from the FDOE. Here is the following comparison data:
- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)- Federal Subgroups 2022 vs 2023- Goal is 41% or higher
