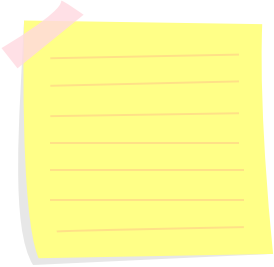

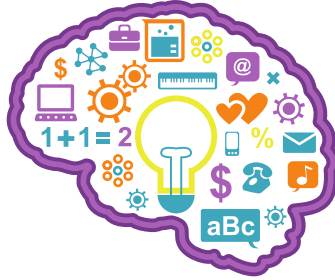
IMPORTANT INFO HERE!

COVID UPDATE ...THE LATEST ON THE PANDEMIC

COVID rules have changed. If your child or someone in your household tests positive the school/school system will no longer quarantine you. We must be notified but we must inform you that we can only accept doctor's notes or parent notes for absences. For example: if your child tests positive with a home test and they are exhibiting symptoms you can either send a parent note for the days they are out or you may take them to the doctor. Remember, each child gets 6 parent notes PER YEAR.
